MEETING A FEW FUTURE BENEFICIAIRES

Jeremie Ndayiragije is 27 years old and lives in the commune headquarters with his family and two children (3 years old and 7 months old). In March of 2009, he left his farm and home and fled to the commune headquarters after his brother was killed. Even though his farm remains in his village, he does not cultivate it as he does not feel safe in his home village about 7 km away from the headquarters. To earn a living he does labor jobs for people. His wife contributes by working on other people's fields. Some days, Jeremie and his family go to sleep without having eaten any food.





Kajisho Cyprien, is 55 years old and lives alone in the commune headquarters because he feels unsafe in his home village. Although he spends the night at the commune headquarters, he farms his land in the village and cultivates plantains, colcase, manioc and potatoes. Despite his advanced age he is able to work his land and receives help from friends. He moved to the commune headquarters from the village on March 28, 2009. Food security and personal safety remain concerns for Mr. Kajisho.

Eric Bandigirianam, is 16 years old. He lives with his older sister in the commune headquarters. His parents do not live with them but send them assistance when they can. He is currently in his second year at primary school and his favorite subject is English. After school, he usually plays with other children. When he grows up Eric wants to be a car mechanic. Eric lacks school stationary and a school uniform.
